## DANVILLE AREA ATTRACTIONS

When the meeting is over, there is plenty to do in Danville. For more detailed information about any of our attractions (hours, fees, etc.), visit our Web site, [www.danvillekentucky.com](http://www.danvillekentucky.com).

- Visit **Constitution Square State Historic Site**, where Kentucky's first constitution was signed more than 200 years ago. A log replica of the meeting house stands on the land where this historic event occurred, along with the courthouse, jail and the original building which housed the first U.S. post office built west of the Allegheny Mountains. You'll also want to allow time to visit the Museum shop, an antique shop, the Historical Society Museum and Wilderness Trace Art League. You may also visit the Convention and Visitors office at Grayson's Tavern, built in 1785 on the grounds of the park.
- Tour **McDowell House and Apothecary**, home of the courageous doctor who performed the world's first successful abdominal surgery on Christmas Day 1809.
- Take a walking tour of **Perryville Battlefield** and its now-quiet countryside, where one of the fiercest battles of the Civil War was fought. Learn how the Battle of Perryville changed history - not only for the state but for the nation.
- Drive through the Knob lands to **Penn's Store**, the oldest family-owned country store in America. This store, run by the same family since 1850, uses a pot-bellied stove for heat and a cigar box cash register.
- Enjoy a live performance at **Pioneer Playhouse**, Kentucky's original outdoor dinner theatre. Productions take place June through August under the stars. You'll also be treated to a tasty dinner, served with a heaping dose of Southern hospitality.
- The historic Old Crow Inn is home to the **Chateau de Vieux Corbeau Winery**, with a tasting room, deli and meeting room. Wooded walking trails surround the vineyards, working pottery studio, bed & breakfast and gift shop.
- Danville is home to an award winning **Model Railroad Museum**. This 25 by 50 foot layout portrays the details of the Louisville-Nashville railroad running through Central and Eastern Kentucky in the fall of the year.
- **Old Bridge Golf Club**, Danville's finest 18-hole golf course, is nestled in next to Herrington Lake. Experienced and novice players alike will enjoy playing this challenging course with its rolling terrain and water hazards on nine holes.
- Visit the **Central Kentucky Wildlife Refuge** - more than 500 acres in the knoblands that reveal the diverse indigenous plants and wildlife found in central Kentucky.
- **Gwinn Island Fishing Resort** offers boating, fishing and water recreation on Herrington Lake, which has the most fish per acre of any lake in Kentucky.
- The original buildings of the 1800s make up **Merchants Row** in historic Perryville. These historic buildings now house gift shops, antique store and museums of the Civil War.

- Visit the unique stores in nearby **Amish and Mennonite Communities** and see quality goods produced without electricity or modern conveniences.
- WKA GoKart racing takes place at **Lightning Valley MotorSports Park** every Saturday, March thru November.

## REGIONAL ATTRACTIONS

Because Danville is centrally located, we're only a short drive from other popular regional attractions. Have your meeting and stay in Danville, and check out any of these attractions for the afternoon:

- **Shaker Village of Pleasant Hill, Harrodsburg.** Shaker Village of Pleasant Hill is the largest restored Shaker community, with 2800 acres of farmland and 33 restored 19th-century buildings. Visitors can view Shaker furniture and artifacts, learn how Shaker crafts were made through live demonstrations, and enjoy a variety of special music and dance performances and special activities. Approximately 13 miles north of Danville.
- **Old Fort Harrod State Park, Harrodsburg.** This reconstructed pioneer fort commemorates the first permanent settlement west of the Alleghenies, built by James Harrod near this site in 1774. The cabins include authentic pioneer furniture and crafts people in pioneer dress demonstrate such skills as blacksmithing, quilting and doll making. Approximately 10 miles north of Danville.
- **Kentucky Artisan Center, Berea.** A 25,000 sq. ft. facility dedicated to the handiwork of Kentucky artisans. Shopping, craft demonstrations, exhibits, regional food and travel information. Approximately 35 miles east of Danville.
- **Kentucky Horse Park, Lexington.** Dedicated to man's relationship with the horse, the Kentucky Horse Park is unlike any other park in the world – a showcase of museums, galleries, theaters, and working farm exhibits. More than 45 breeds of horses graze upon its lush pastures. Approximately 45 miles north of Danville.
- **Wild Turkey Distillery, Lawrenceburg.** In 1893, bourbon from this distillery was selected from over 400 whiskeys to represent Kentucky at the World's Fair. The same fine 101 proof Wild Turkey bourbon is still made today. Visitors will tour the fermentation and bottling areas as well as timbered warehouses to experience the sites, sounds and smells of a working distillery. Approximately 30 miles north of Danville.
